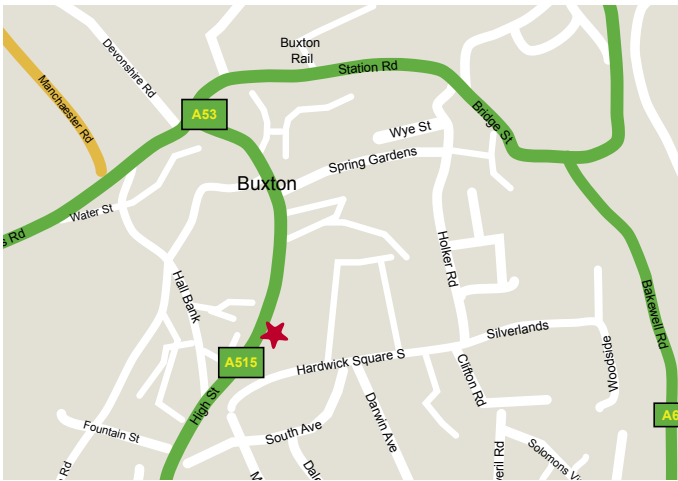

Getting to the Court

By Car From the A50 take the A515 to Ashbourne, then the A515 to Buxton. Follow signs to town centre. The road you come into Buxton on is Terrace Rd. Lots of pay-and-display car parking on the left at the Market Place and a Sainsbury's free car park.

Parking £3 for 4hrs



By Train/Bus Trains run from Euston to Stockport hourly, change for Buxton (three hours). From the station turn right down Station Rd to the roundabout. Turn left at the roundabout onto Terrace Rd. Head down the hill, then back up. The Court is on the left on the hill just after you pass The Slopes on the right and the Town Hall.

Understanding the Court

Days Open Once a week only, usually on a Tuesday.

Opening/Sitting Times Building open 09.00–16.00, court office open 10.00–16.00. Court sits from 10.30 unless there is an urgent application when it will sit earlier.

Using the Court

Arriving Sign in with the usher on the first floor. Same usher as for the magistrates'. Will ask if you are there for the magistrates' or county and will point you in the right direction.



Waiting Waiting area on the 1st floor. No advocates' room. Vending machine on first floor.

Preparing General office on the second floor. Charge for faxes/photocopying of £5 for first 10 pages and 50p per page thereafter. Two interview rooms on first floor within the waiting area but at least one interview room shared with the magistrates' court.

Performing One hearing room—DJ. There is a traffic light system in waiting area for waiting cases.

Listings DJ sits in Courtroom Two, first floor. Telephone hearings available. Miscellaneous business morning; small claims in afternoon. Fast and multi-track cases heard at Chesterfield/Notts/Derby or Mansfield.

Escaping the Court

Eating

No time? There is a deli/sandwich shop next door to the court and Sainsbury's a few mins walk away—turn left out of court building.

More time? There are cafes and sandwich shops two mins walk away—turn right and walk down the hill from the court.

Killing time? There are restaurants/pubs in the High St and Market St area. Turn left out of the court. Try The Place: 01298 214565.

Shopping

Nearest cashpoint is at Sainsbury's or the Co-op, turn left out of the court one-min walk. The shopping area, including the Cavendish Arcade with its boutique feel, is mainly situated at the junction of Terrace and Station Rds.

Attractions

Buxton is in the heart of the Peak District and is a famous spa town, from which you can explore the area. Visit stately homes such as Haddon Hall, Hardwick Hall and Bolsover Castle. Buxton also has an ornamental pavilion with lovely gardens.
