

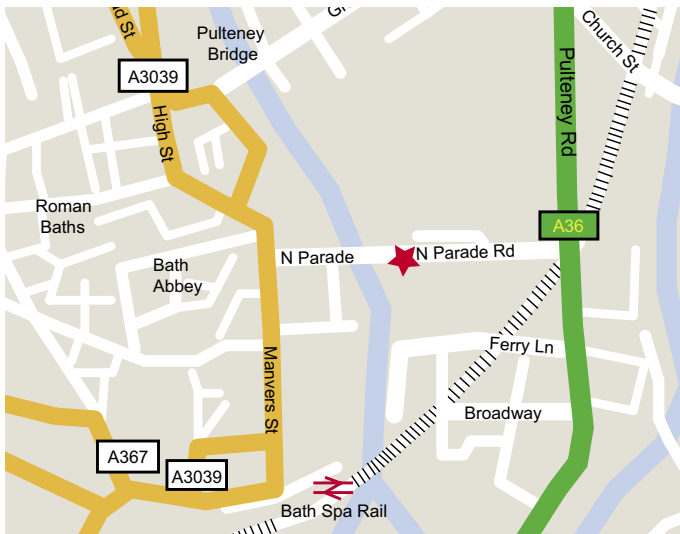

Getting to the Court

By Car From the M4 J18 take the A46 towards Bath. Follow for approx seven miles and take the slip road signposted A4. At the roundabout turn right along the A4 towards the city centre. After approx one mile turn left into Cleveland Pl, which becomes Bathwick St (A36). At the roundabout take 2nd exit onto Sydney Pl, bearing left onto Darlington St. At next roundabout go straight ahead onto Pulteney Rd and at the traffic lights turn right into North Parade Rd. The closest car park is a pay-and-display cash car park on Manvers St. Carry on along North Parade Rd to the end, turn left at the traffic lights onto Pierrepoint St, which becomes Manvers St. Parking is on the left.

By Train/Bus Direct trains from London Paddington (one hour 30 mins) run every 30 mins. From the train station, walk straight ahead onto Manvers St, which becomes Pierrepoint St. Turn right, over the river, onto North Parade Rd. The court is at the end of the road on the left, approx three mins away. There is a very small taxi rank at the station.

Understanding the Court

Days Open Mon–Fri.

Opening/Sitting Times Building open 09.00–16.30, court office open 9.30–16.00. Court sits from 10.00.

Using the Court

Arriving Security searches and detectors in operation. Sign in with security and usher.

Waiting Secure advocates' room. Vending machines.

Preparing The court office counter is on the ground floor, in the main waiting area. No charge for faxes received/sent but photocopying charged at £5 for first 10 pages and then 50p per page.

Performing Two hearing/courtrooms, but usually only one in use.

Listings Hearings are usually listed by estimated hearing length, but multiple listing also occurs. Telephone hearings and conferences possible.

Escaping the Court

Eating

No time? There are a number of cafes and sandwich shops on York St, two to three mins away.

More time? There are several restaurants on North Parade Road, one to two mins away. Try One Fish Two Fish (not Mondays): 01225 330236.

Killing time? Treat yourself to lunch/afternoon tea in the Pump Room restaurant within the historical Roman Baths, next to Bath Abbey: 01225 444477.

Shopping

The nearest cashpoint is on the corner of Manvers St and Henry St, walking towards the train station. For the main pedestrianised shopping area, walk back along North Parade Rd and cross Pierrepoint St, carrying on onto York St, past the Abbey and Roman Baths, until you reach Stall St, which runs left and right, into Union St.

Attractions

The new Bath therma spa is a modern spa with an outdoor rooftop pool and aromatherapy steam rooms. The Roman Baths are a popular historical attraction. Bath Abbey conducts hourly tours between 10.00 and 15.00.
