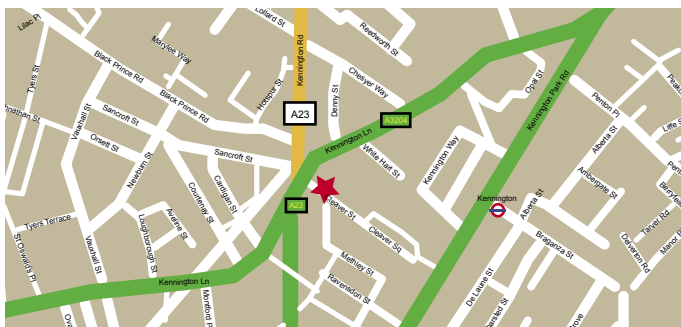


### Getting to the Court

**By Car** From the M25 J2 take the A2 towards London. At New Cross bear left onto Queen's Road and follow the A202 towards Peckham. Continue along the A202: Peckham High St then Peckham Rd, Camberwell Church St and Camberwell New Rd: and then bear right onto the A23 Brixton Rd and bear right again onto the A3, Kennington Park Rd. Turn left at the next junction onto the A23, Kennington Rd. Bear right onto the A3204. Kennington Lane and Cleaver St/Sq is the next right turn, with the White Hart pub on the corner.

Vast majority of parking in the area is residential permit only. Extremely limited pay & display/metered parking spaces around Cleaver St/Cleaver Sq. Four hours max stay.

**By Train/Bus** The nearest tube station is Kennington, Northern Line. From the station exit turn left. Take the 2nd right turning into Cleaver Square. Walk straight through the square, the exit being Cleaver St. The Court is on the right, about halfway along Cleaver Street.

### Understanding the Court

**Days Open** Mon– Fri.

**Opening/Sitting Times** Building 09.00–16.00. Court office 09.30–16.00. Court usually sits from 10.00

**Listings** Hearings are normally listed by estimated hearing length. Telephone and video hearings/conferences possible.

### Using the Court

**Arriving** Security gates and searches. The court lists are attached to the left side of the stairs, straight ahead. Sign in with the individual court ushers.

**Waiting** Unsecured advocates' rooms (separate male and female), with toilets, on the 1st floor. Drinks vending machine. Large waiting area on the 1st floor.

**Preparing** The lists are found in the waiting area and the court office is on the ground floor. Photocopying/faxes cost £5 for the first 10 pages and 50p per page after that. There are two interview rooms.

**Performing** There are three court rooms and three DJs' hearing rooms.

### Escaping the Court

#### Eating

**No time?** Turn right out of the Court, and at the end of Cleaver St turn hard left into Kennington Park Rd where there are a number of cafes.

**More time?** There are several pleasant pubs nearby that serve food. The Prince of Wales is tucked into a corner in Cleaver Sq, the White Hart is at the end of Cleaver St. Opposite the White Hart, on Kennington Lane, you will find The Doghouse.

**Gourmet option** The Court is less than three miles from the London borough of Chelsea, home to Restaurant Gordon Ramsey on Royal Hospital Rd, now a three-starred Michelin establishment. Lunch is served between 12 and 14.30, with a set menu available. Dress code applies: 020 7352 4441; [www.gordonramsay.com](http://www.gordonramsay.com). #### Shopping

Three stops away on the Northern line is Charing Cross, from where Covent Garden is a short walk away. Victoria/Mayfair can be reached by heading west along Kennington Lane and over Vauxhall Bridge. Turn right out of the court and diagonally left at the end of Cleaver St. The nearest cashpoint to the court is in a newsagents, east along Kennington Lane, turn right out of court and right at the end of Cleaver St. The shop is a few doors along.

#### Attractions

From Kennington it is a short walk to the Oval Cricket Ground. Buckingham Palace, Hyde Park Corner and The Chelsea Embankment are a short taxi ride away. From Kennington station, Charing Cross and Trafalgar Square are three stops away on the Northern line.
