Getting to the Court

By Car M1 J24, take the A453 and follow signs to Nottingham city centre until the flyover. Go over the flyover towards the city centre, passing industrial estates on the left and through sets of traffic lights, until you reach the lights with a station sign to the right. Take the left lane and go straight on over the canal. Take the right lane and at next lights turn right. Then at the next lights, still in right lane, go straight on. Road bears right and car park on right (Broadmarsh), opposite the court. Enter at far end. Pay on return.

By Train/Bus Direct trains run from St Pancras every 30 mins (two hours). Station taxi rank. Turn right out of the station and go along Carrington St, over the canal, to the traffic lights. Turn right onto Canal Street and the court is on the right.

Understanding the Court

Days Open Mon–Fri.

Opening/Sitting Times Building open 09.00–16.00, court office open 10.00–16.00. Court sits from 10.00.



Using the Court

Arriving Security searches and detectors in operation. Sign in with usher. There is a lift.

Waiting Secure advocates' room available with toilets nearby secure from public access, both located on the second floor. You will need to ask for assistance in advance to arrange access if you have not used them before. Vending machines and court cafe.

Preparing The court office is on the ground floor. Charge for photocopying/faxes of £5 for first 10 pages and 50p per page thereafter. There are two interview rooms available on the ground floor but when local advice agencies attend court they may be occupied.

Performing Number of courts used by County Court varies each day. Ten courts in the building shared between Crown and County. Usually two County Courts sitting: one ground and one first floor, but can be more. Magistrates' Court also sometimes used for County Court matters.

Listings Hearings are usually listed by estimated hearing length but multiple listing also occurs. Telephone hearings and conferences possible. Cases can also be listed in the Magistrates' Court building.

Escaping the Court

Eating

No time? There is a court cafe with a separate advocates' area on second floor.

More time? The Broadmarsh Centre, behind the carpark, leads to the city centre, where there are plenty of cafes/sandwich shops and cashpoints.

Killing time? Hart's restaurant is renowned in Nottingham, on Standard Hill, Park Row: 0115 9110666.
