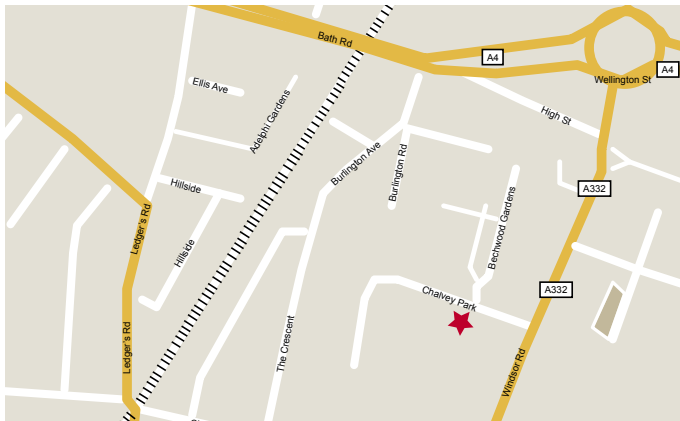

## Getting to the Court

### By car

From London, take the M4 to J5. At the roundabout take 4th exit for the A4 (London Rd), signposted Langley. Straight ahead at the next roundabout. At the next roundabout turn left onto A332 (William St becoming Windsor Rd) and take the 3rd right into Chalvey Park; the County Court is behind the Magistrates' Court. Limited metered parking outside the court, max stay 3 hours. Two car parks on Herschel Street—turn left on Windsor Rd just before you get level with Chalvey Park.

*Limited meter parking: 3 hrs £3.50*



### By train/bus

Trains leave from Paddington Station, with numerous train operators, very frequently. Journey time 15–32 mins. Turn right out of the station and then turn left at the junction with the main road (William Rd). Walk down the steps and right into the subway, and then bear diagonally right towards the subway exit marked High St/Library/Town Hall. Take the steps on your left to street level. Follow the road ahead (Windsor Rd) and the courts are on the corner of the 2nd road on the right (Chalvey Park). The County Court is behind the police station and the Magistrates' Court.

*5–10 min walk; Subway steps not trolley friendly*

## Understanding the Court

**Days open** Mon– Fri. Probate appointments Thursdays only.

**Opening/Sitting times** Building 09.00–16.00, Court office 09.00 for bankruptcy matters, 10.00 for all other matters, until 16.00. Court usually sits from 10.00.

**Listings** Hearings are usually listed by estimated hearing length, but multiple listing does occur.

## Using the Court

**Arriving** Security gate on entry. Sign in with the ushers.

**Waiting** There is a secure advocates' room and toilet. Drinks vending machine available. Waiting space/seating is limited just inside the main entrance/exit.

**Preparing** The Court office counter is to the right of the building entrance/exit. Photocopying/faxes cost £5 for the first 10 pages and 50p per page after that. There are two interview rooms in the building. They are always over-subscribed as this is a very busy Court.

**Performing** The County Court consists of five hearing/court rooms.

## Escaping the Court

### Eating

**No time?** The nearest eatery is Subway on Windsor Rd (1 min away).

**More time?** There are numerous cafes/fast food restaurants/pubs on the High St, to the left and right of Windsor Rd. Not far along the High St is Francesco's Italian restaurant: 01753 530005; [www.francescos.org.uk](http://www.francescos.org.uk). Some 10–15 mins walk away on Upton Park Road (head away from the High St up Windsor Rd and turn left after Albert St) is the Temple Monkey Indian restaurant: 01753 528 797; [www.thetemple-monkey.co.uk](http://www.thetemple-monkey.co.uk)

**Gourmet option** Slough is a short distance (approx 20 mins drive) to the UK's two Michelin-starred restaurants holding three stars: The Fat Duck and The Waterside Inn, both in Bray, Berks. The Fat Duck is open for lunch (12.00–14.00) and dinner (19.00–21.30) Tuesday to Saturday and for lunch on Sunday: 01628 580 333; [www.fatduck.co.uk](http://www.fatduck.co.uk). The Waterside Inn is open for lunch (12.00–14.00) and dinner (19.00–22.00) Wednesday to Sunday, plus dinner on Tuesdays during the summer: 01628 620691; [www.waterside-inn.co.uk](http://www.waterside-inn.co.uk).

### Shopping

The main shopping centre is on the High St. Walk back along Windsor Rd towards the station and turn right or left just before you reach the roundabout. There is a rear exit to the indoor shopping centre (Queensmere) that takes you past a large Tesco extra and back to the station. The nearest cashpoints are on the High St in either direction (2–3 mins away).

### Attractions

Slough is very close to Windsor with its horse shows, Castle and Legoland theme park. It is also close to Ascot racecourse and Saville ornamental gardens. The Thames Pathway is a renowned walking area.

## Accommodation

There is a Travelodge very close to the Court, just off Windsor Rd: 0871 984 6253. The Upton Park Hotel is a newly refurbished hotel within walking distance of the court, and houses the Temple Monkey Indian restaurant: 01753 528 797; [www.uptonparkguesthouse.co.uk](http://www.uptonparkguesthouse.co.uk).
